#### 1. PURPOSE

To appoint a Professional Service Provider (PSP) to implement Corporate Social Investment (CSI) projects of the IUCMA. The IUCMA continues to investigate opportunities of investing in communities within the Water Management Area (WMA) to create long-term socio-economic benefits for all. By improving the economic well-being of individuals, the IUCMA envisage that, over time, this initiative will contribute to the resilience of the environment and the communities, as well as the creation of social value. The IUCMA therefore seeks to become a significant role player in the field of community upliftment.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

The Inkomati-Usuthu Catchment Management Agency (IUCMA) is the water resource management agency in the Inkomati-Usuthu Water Management Area (WMA) established interms of Section 78 of the National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998), (NWA) to perform water resource management at catchment level. The management of the resources entails protection, use, development, conservation, management, and control of water resources within the WMA as contemplated in the NWA. It is also listed as a national public entity in Schedule 3A of the Public Finance Management Act (Act 1 of 1999). The IUCMA however, is not responsible for provision of potable water. As a government entity, the IUCMA understands its responsibility to improve lives of communities within which it exists. It embraces CSI as a strategic tool through which it can contribute towards social development and economic growth within the WMA. CSI can potentially project IUCMA as a responsible public citizen while providing a secondary platform for corporate branding and marketing. IUCMA's CSI Programme is aligned to the institutional vision, mission, and strategic focus. To give effect to this intent, the IUCMA commits itself to invest in the development and empowerment projects that embrace the diversity of stakeholders in an equitable manner.

#### 3. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The main aim of the IUCMA CSI initiative is:

To contribute to sustainable economic development and empowerment of communities within the WMA.

#### 4. SCOPE OF WORK

The project entails siting drilling, pumping test, water quality test, equipping, reticulation and solar power supply of three (3) boreholes (one borehole per Ward). The scope of work is based on the following phased approach (Refer to Annexure 1 for the bill of quantities):

PHASE I: Geophysics

PHASE II: Drilling

PHASE III: Pumping test and water quality analysis, equipping and borehole housing

PHASE IV: Reticulation system (supply, construction, and installation)

Annexure 1 details the bill of quantities for the three boreholes at maximum completion depth of hundred meters (100 m).

#### 5. METHODOLOGY

The proposed methodology to achieve the scope of work above shall be as outlined in the subsequent sections.

#### **5.1 PHASE I: GEOPHYSICS**

- Any or combination of a two-dimensional (2D) resistivity/Electromagnetic and/or magnetic survey based on the desk study results,
- Phase I report:
- Geophysics results and interpretation, and
- Geospatial location of drill targets (google satellite and geological maps and coordinates).

#### **5.2 PHASE II: DRILLING**

- · Drilling depth:
- Maximum of 100 m below ground level (mbgl) (this will be guided by drilling supervision).
- · Drilling diameter:
- 8-inch (203 mm) in soft formations (from surface-to hard rock)
- 6.5-inch (165 mm) from hard rock to a completed depth.
- Borehole construction
- Steel starter casing of 8-inch,
- 165mm (OD) x 3mm plane steel casing,
- 152 mm (OD) X 3mm machine slotted uPVC casing (the aquiferous zones will accordingly be lined with perforated casing).
- The annulus between the casing and the borehole must be gravel packed with a 1.5 mm dry graded silica from completed depth to 2 mbgl.
- Bentonite seal overtop the gravel pack to 0.5 mbgl.
- Cement grouted (cement slurry 1.85-2.15 kg / litre) sanitary seal
- Phase II report
- Borehole logs (geology, water strikes and blow yields),
- · Penetration rates, and
- Borehole construction.

### 5.3 PHASE III: PUMPING TEST AND WATER QUALITY ANALYSIS, EQUIPPING AND BOREHOLE HOUSING

- Between three (3) and five (5) one (1) hour long stepped drawdown test,
- 12–24-hour constant discharge test,
- Sampling during pumping test for lab analysis of
- Macro (anion and cations) and micro chemical constituents
- Microbiological test (total faecal coliforms and E. coli)
- Equipping, power supply and borehole housing (supply and install)
- At least between 0.75-kW and 2-kW 4-inch (quantities will be measurable depending on the recommended yield) submersible solar pump, motor, and associated components, such as pipes etc.
- Pump should deliver at least 2 litres a second (2 l/s) at a head of 150 m (pump installation

depth and distance to storage/water tank).

- At least 6 x 350v solar panels and associated components, (e.g., automated control unit, cables, sockets, mounting brackets etc.).
- Solar panels on top of nearby house roof (100m-200m tentative distance from borehole).
- Float switch in the water tank connected to panels' automated control unit (connection cable length to be determined later;100m-200m tentative length)
- Flow meter at borehole outlet pipe to records pumped volumes.
- Burry connection cables between panels, water tank, and borehole underground (25cm to 30cm)
- Weld borehole base plate onto borehole casing after connecting to solar panels
- Concrete manhole ring and cover installation
- 0.5 m x 0.5 m borehole concrete slab with 0.2 m height
- 2.5m height manhole ring (1m buried below ground surface, 1.5m aboveground surface)
- Ring diameter of at least 1m to 1.25m
- Concrete frame and cover (concrete or conventional cast iron lid)
- Phase III report
  - Pumping test data,
  - o Aquifer parameters (well efficiency, hydraulic conductivity/transmissivity),
  - Borehole sustainable yield,
  - Recommended pumping cycles (abstraction schedules),
  - o Proposed pump depth,
  - Chemical and microbiological data vs SANS 241:2015, and
  - o Equipping, power supply and borehole housing.

### 5.5 PHASE IV: RETICULATION SYSTEM (SUPPLY, CONSTRUCTION, AND INSTALLATION)

- 1 X 10 000 litres storage tanks (water tank or similar),
- 1 X tank stand (as per drawing),
- Install a 20m (30HDPE Class 6 pipeline) water transfer pipes from borehole to tank,
- Install two stand taps with apron slabs (width 1.25m x length 1.50m xheight 0.2m),
- Connect water transfer pipes from tank to stand taps with a 20m (20HDPE Class 6 pipeline)

#### 6. RECOMMENDED TANK STAND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

(Refer to the drawings attached for specifications)

- Level the ground as evenly as possible.
- Place the frame on the ground where you want to install the tank stand.
- Mark the four by one square meter foundations on the ground.
- Dig the four foundations 1m deep.
- Place 50mm spacers on the ground and place the tank stand on top of the spacers.
- Place a spirit level on the tank stand and set it level on all 4 corners.
- Make sure the tank stand is firm on the ground and cast the concrete around the metal legs of the stand until the concrete is level with the ground.
- Leave the concrete until it sets and place the tank on top of the stand and tie it down with wires or cables on the corners.

#### 7. PROJECT LOCATION AND PERIOD

The project will be executed in the eastern parts of the Ehlanzeni District (Nkomazi Local Municipality) within Inkomati-Usuthu Water Management Area effective from the date of the signing of the contract, retention will be paid within six (6) months of the contract period.
