- a. IUCMA does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any RFQ, nor shall it be responsible for or pay any expenses or losses which may be incurred by the bidder in the preparation and delivery of the RFQ.
- b. No RFQ shall be deemed to have been accepted unless and until a purchase order/letter of appointment is prepared and executed.
- c. Quotation shall remain open for acceptance by IUCMA for a period of **120 days** from the closing date of the RFQ enquiry.
- 4.1 IUCMA reserves the right to:
- a. Not evaluate and award RFQ that do not comply strictly with the requirements of this RFQ.

APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES FOR REVIEW OF RECOVERABILITY OF DEBT

1. PURPOSE

The Inkomati-Usuthu Catchment Management Agency (IUCMA) is a water resources management institution established by the National Water Act 36 of 1998. The IUCMA to adequately execute its constitutional mandate must ensure the integrity of its financial and reporting system.

2. BACKGROUND

The Inkomati-Usuthu Catchment Management Agency (IUCMA) is established in terms of Section 78 of the National Water Act, Act 36 of 1998 (NWA) to perform water resource management at catchment level. This entails the protection, use, development, conservation, management, and control of water resources within the Inkomati-Usuthu WMA, as of Section 84 (2), the main funding channels of the Agency is through money appropriated by parliament and water use charges.

However, the IUCMA only received delegations to charge water resource management charges on the 1st of November 2017 wherein it inherited a debt book of R199 million. The debtors book inherited contained approximately 3,496 registered water users whose balances were deemed provision upon transfer date. The transferred provisional figure in accordance with GRAP 105, National Treasury Guidelines Section 11.4, and PFMA Section 76 (1) (e) and 76 (4) (a), as the Agency obtained new information about the facts and circumstances that existed as of acquisition date, was restated as follows:

3. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The Public Finance Management Act 1 of 1999, (PFMA) section 38(1)(c)(i) and (d) and Chapter 11 of the Treasury Regulations provide guidance on the management of assets of the Agency. The PFMA further gives guidance in terms of writing off debts owing to the state as per Sections 76(1)(e) and 76(4)(a) of the PFMA.

The main objective of this project is to ensure any amounts proposed for write-off to the Governing Board are assessed for recoverability using a modality that is permissible within the public sector. An affirmation of write-off should be tested based on the below aspects as mandated by the PMFA:

- i. Confirmation that all reasonable steps have been taken to recover the debt;
- ii. Indication that recovery of the debt would be uneconomical;
- iii. Indication that recovery would cause undue hardship to the debtor or his or her dependents; or

iv. Indication that it would be to the advantage of the Agency to affect a settlement of its claim or to waive the claim.

4. SCOPE OF WORK/ DELIVERABLES

The service provider must ensure that all proposed write-offs are correctly assessed and computed with correct monetary value. The service provider must ensure that due diligence is done on each debtor as per chapter 11 of the Treasury Regulations. In addition, supporting evidence must be presented to the entity indicating that a particular debt cannot be turned into revenue and as such be deemed irrecoverable.

5. PROJECT PERIOD

The project will be executed within twelve (12) months.

6. VALIDITY OF PROPOSALS

The Bidder is required to confirm that it will hold its proposal valid for **120 days** from the closing date of the submission of proposals, during which time it will maintain without change, the personnel proposed for the services together with their proposed rates.
