- The successful service provider must submit a valid letter of good standing/ or Letter for tender purposes from the department of labour.
- The service provider must have at least one light delivery vehicle. (Attach proof of ownership / letter of intent to lease/ lease agreement.)
- Bidders must attach proof of residence i.e municipal accounts, lease of residence, letter from traditional leaders, however proof of residence from municipal council will not be accepted

1. INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND

The IUCMA is owning the Piet Retief office and the gardening/ landscaping services need to be performed daily. For this reason, the entity seeks to appoint a service provider to perform gardening/ landscaping services at Piet Retief for a period of twenty-four (24) months.

2. OBJECTIVES

- To protect the health of employees and comply with hygiene regulations.
- Reduction and ultimately preventing occupational illness and injury.
- Ensure cleanness and good gardening of IUCMA offices.

3. PROJECT DURATION

The IUCMA requires the services of a PSP to perform gardening/ landscaping services at IUCMA Piet Retief offices for a period of twenty-four (24) months.

4. scope of work

The service provider will be responsible for the following:

- Provide all the necessary supervision, labour, tools, equipment and perform maintenance of gardening services.
- The service provider must at least have the minimum required equipment which amongst others includes grass cutting machine, trees/ plants cutting machine, wheelbarrow, spades, shovels, forks, PPE for the gardener, etc. The service provider must submit proof of all the required

equipment which will be proof of ownership / letter of intent to lease/ confirmation letter confirming that the service provider is having all the equipment.

- Cutting of grass, garden maintenance, beatification and litter picking at landscape, plants, trees and around the office building as and when required by IUCMA.
- Removal of weeds and papers, litter picking, sweeping of paved walkway.
- Sweeping of curbs of the road after every cut.

6. The following CONDITIONS will apply to the successful service provider

- The gardening/ landscaping shall be maintained at least twice a week.
- the cutting schedules allocated to service provider may be updated as and when required.
- The service provider shall collect and remove all litter and foreign objects from the site prior to cutting and dispose of it in an approved refuse site within Piet Retief/ Mkhondo.
- The service provider shall remove all grass cuttings and waste bags from the site on the same day.
- Grass cuttings deposited on tarred/ paved areas shall be swept and removed on the same day.
- All the lawns shall be neatly trimmed and maintained at a height not less than 35mm and not greater than 60mm.
- The service provider shall inform the IUCMA of any damages caused by the service provider's operation on the day such damages occur.
- Any damages to property as a result of the service provider's operation shall be the responsibility of the service provider.
- Should the damages not be rectified within the time agreed upon or to the satisfaction of the IUCMA, the institution reserves the right to repair or replace the damaged items and deduct these costs from any payment due to the service provider.
- All reasonable care shall be taken to prevent injury to people or damage to property by ensuring that equipment is properly maintained, and regular safety checks performed to ensure they are in good working order and equipped with the required safety devises.
- The service provider shall provide adequate barricades, signs and /or warning devices during the performance of the contract to protect motorists and pedestrians. All placement of signs and barricades must conform the Traffic Safety Standards.
- Any accident, however minor, shall be verbally reported to the IUCMA followed by a written report within 24 hours.
- The service provider shall comply with the OHS Act.
- No portion of the work/ contract shall be sub-contracted or assigned without the approval and consent of the IUCMA.
- Awarding of the bid will be subject to the service provider's express acceptance of the general conditions of contract.
- The service provider worker/s must be registered with Unemployment insurance fund (UIF) under the company name of the service provider.
- The successful service provider agrees to keep confidential all records and information and not to disclose such records or information to any third party without the prior written consent of IUCMA.
- The IUCMA reserves the right to terminate the contract if there is clear evidence of non-performance and/or inability to deliver.
- IUCMA reserves the right not to make any appointment.
- IUCMA encourages black people who are woman and youth owning 51% black ownership and people with disabilities to participate in the advertised bid.

NB: GCC of 2010 will be applicable on procurement of goods and service.

7. Pricing schedule
