# APPOINTMENT OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE PROVIDER TO PROVIDE OFFICE RENOVATION AT INKOMATI- USUTHU CATCHMENT MANAGEMENT AGENCY PIET RETIEF OFFICE

### 1. INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND

The IUCMA has a satellite office in Piet Retief which requires renovation. The services of a Professional Service Provider (PSP) are required to conclude this project.

### 2. OBJECTIVES

The aim of this project is to ensure that the satellite office is conducive for the working environment, which must comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Construction industry Development Board (CIDB).

### 3. SERVICES REQUIRED

The IUCMA requires the services of a Professional Service Provider to provide office renovation at Inkomati-Usuthu Catchment Management Agency Piet Retief Office as a once-off project.

### 4. SCOPE OF WORK

See attached Bill of Quantities

### 5. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

All bids will be examined to determine compliance with bidding requirements and conditions. The proposals will be verified against all administrative requirements of the bid which include the completeness of the Standard Bidding Documents. Bidders who do not fulfil all the requirements or do not submit the required documents will be disqualified and not be evaluated further on compulsory requirements. The compliance requirements include the following:

- Registration on the national treasury central supplier database (CSD).
- Registration with CIDB on 2GB or higher.
- Standard bidding documents must be fully completed and signed, where the answer is not applicable, it must be indicated with N/A, failure to complete will result in disqualification.
- Standard bidding documents 1, 4, 6.1, 6.2, 8 and 9.

# NB: Failure to comply with the mandatory requirements will results in disqualification.

### 6. EVALUATION PROCESS

The bid will be evaluated and adjudicated on two (2) different phases as follows:

- i. Phase 1: Mandatory Requirements
- ii. Phase 2: Price and BBBEE evaluation

### Phase 2: Price and BBBEE Evaluation in terms of 80/20 Preference Points System

- All bids will be evaluated on price and BBBEE only, as the Construction Industry Development Board (standard for uniformity in engineering and construction works contracts) for 2019 stipulates that bids that will be deemed simple/straightforward/routing works, no functionality criteria shall be specified in the tender data as per clause 4.3.2.1. of the CIDB regulation 2019.
- Only preferential point system and BBBEE will be applicable 80/20 preference points system. Allocation of points for B-BBEE status level is set out in table 2 below.

- Should the damages not be rectified within the time agreed upon or to the satisfaction of the IUCMA, the institution reserves the right to repair or replace the damaged items and deduct these costs from any payment due to the service provider.
- All reasonable care shall be taken to prevent injury to people or damage to property by ensuring that equipment is properly maintained, and regular safety checks performed to ensure they are in good working order and equipped with the required safety devises.
- The service provider shall provide adequate barricades, signs and /or warning devices during the performance of the contract to protect employees, motorists and pedestrians. All placement of signs and barricades must conform the Traffic Safety Standards.
- Any accident, however minor, shall be verbally reported to the IUCMA followed by a written report within 24 hours.
- The service provider shall comply with the OHS Act.
- No portion of the work/ contract shall be sub-contracted or assigned without the approval and consent of the IUCMA.
- Awarding of the bid will be subject to the service provider's express acceptance of the general conditions of contract.
- The service provider worker/s must be registered with Unemployment insurance fund (UIF) under the company name of the service provider.
- The successful service provider agrees to keep confidential all records and information and not to disclose such records or information to any third party without the prior written consent of IUCMA.
- The IUCMA reserves the right to terminate the contract if there is clear evidence of nonperformance and/or inability to deliver.
- IUCMA reserves the right not to make any appointment

### <u>Bulkheads</u>

Bulkheads are those areas of the ceiling which are at a level differing from the general ceiling in a particular room or area and which generally occur along the perimeter of the room or area. Their purpose is either to conceal services or to create an architectural feature by changing levels.

Bulkheads will only be measured as such when they conform with the above description and when the horizontal or vertical dimensions do not exceed 1,200mm. Where these dimensions exceed 1,200mm the horizontal or vertical ceilings are included in the general ceiling measurements

- (f) **"functionality"** means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender documents.
- (g) "prices" includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (h) "proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor" means:
  - 1) B-BBEE Status level certificate issued by an authorized body or person;
  - 2) A sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice;
  - 3) Any other requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act;
- "QSE" means a qualifying small business enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (j) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;

#### POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

#### 3.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:
